6. Insurance Requirements

The State of California, its officers, agents, and employees are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of work or operations.

Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned, and hired vehicles with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and property damage. The State of California, its officers, agents, and employees are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of work or operations. Workers Compensation & Employers Liability Workers' Compensation Insurance as required by the State of California, with Statutory Limits, and Employer's Liability Insurance with limit of no less than \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury or disease. The Workers' Compensation policy shall be endorsed with a waiver of subrogation in favor of the State of California.
